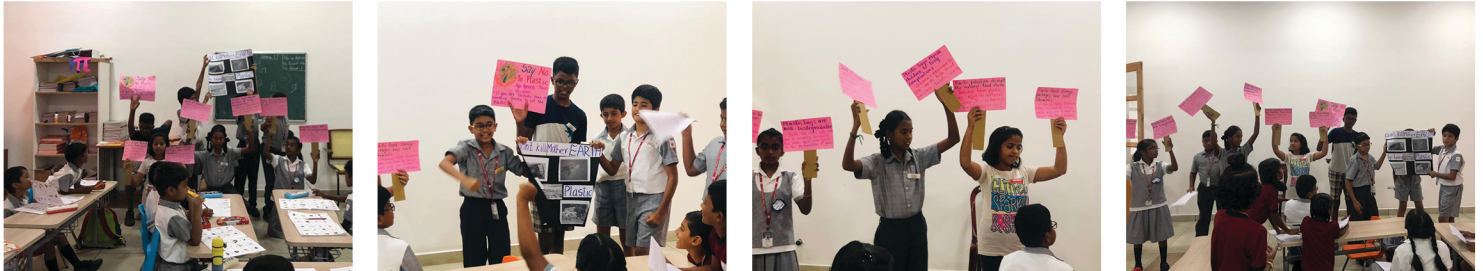
Janmashtami Celebration (23rd August 2019)

National Sports day (29th August 2019)

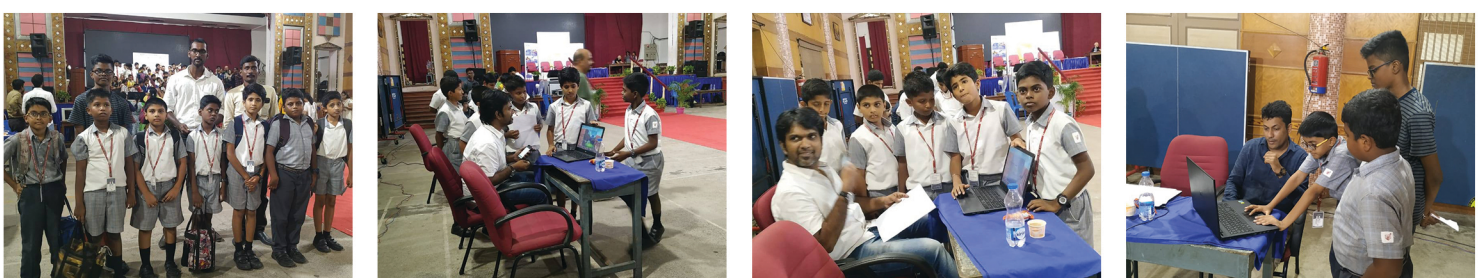

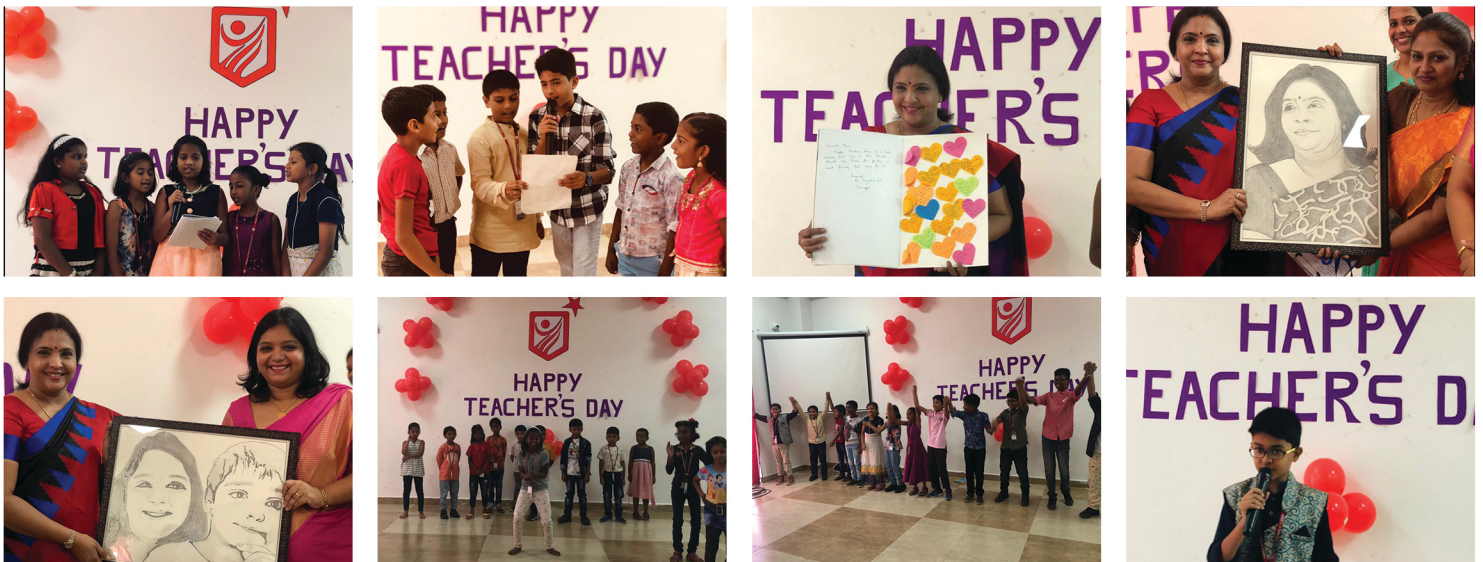
Ganesh Chaturthi (03rd September 2019)

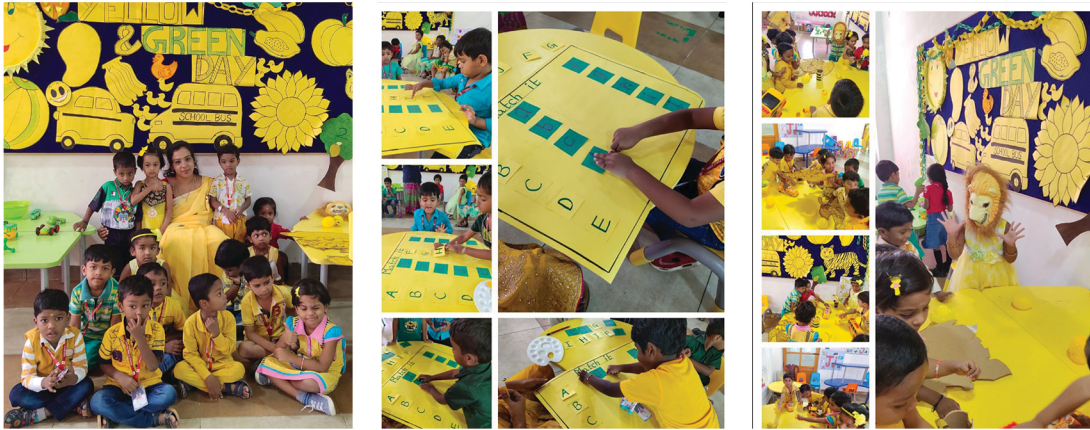
Teacher's day

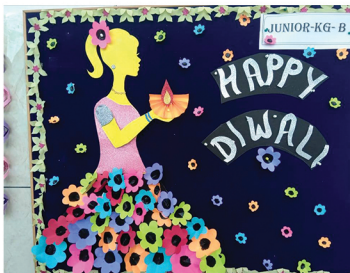
World Student's Day (15th October 2019)
